BARR is a K-12 partner with a quarter-century track record of:

- raising student math and reading scores,
- increasing teacher satisfaction and retention, and
- decreasing student absenteeism, disciplinary incidents and suspensions.

The BARR model has worked for hundreds of schools in the nation, including over 60 schools in Minnesota, in all types of geographies and systems, alongside any number of existing curricular partnerships.





Responding to demand from schools, the 2023 Minnesota legislature approved \$5M to fund 18 new BARR schools. Urban, suburban and rural schools were selected from over 50 deserving schools that applied in August. Many more continue to express interest.

\$10,000,000 for 36 additional BARR Schools

HF 3378, Rep. Cheryl Youakim, Hopkins, SF 3539, Sen. Aric Putnam, St. Cloud, funds 36 additional schools in rural, suburban and urban areas. Funding provides schools with coaching support, professional development, curriculum and resources, and access to the national network of BARR educators over three years. Work will focus on:

- 1. Increasing opportunity and academic achievement for all students, with a focus on Black, Indigenous, and People of Color
- 2. Improving student social and emotional skills and engagement in school
- 3. Improving teacher satisfaction and effectiveness
- 4. Increasing the number of students who earn a high school diploma

"I've been teaching for 31 years and for a lot of those years I felt like I was on an island when dealing with students who struggled. I tried to figure it out by myself, there was nothing set up for me to communicate with other teachers, I'd throw something out there and hope it worked, oftentimes it did not.
