1.2 Page 3, delete section 4 and insert:

1.3 "Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 331A.03, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Generally.** Except as provided in subdivision 2 or section 645.11, a
1.5 public notice shall be published in a qualified newspaper, and except as otherwise provided
1.6 by law, in one that is likely to give notice in the affected area or to whom it is directed.
1.7 When a statute or other law requires publication in a newspaper located in a designated
1.8 political subdivision or area and no qualified newspaper is located there, publication shall
1.9 be made in a qualified newspaper likely to give notice unless the particular statute or law
1.10 expressly provides otherwise. If no qualified newspaper exists, then publication is not
1.11 required."

1.12 Page 5, after line 4, insert:

1.13 "Sec. 8. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 645.11, is amended to read:

1.14 **645.11 PUBLISHED NOTICE.**

1.15 Unless otherwise specifically provided, the words "published notice," when used in
1.16 reference to the giving of notice in any proceeding or the service of any summons, order,
1.17 or process in judicial proceedings, mean the publication in full of the notice, or other paper
1.18 referred to, in the regular issue of a qualified newspaper, once each week for the number
1.19 of weeks specified. When the publication day of any newspaper falls upon Thanksgiving
1.20 Day, or upon any legal holiday, the publication of notice in any proceeding or the publication
1.21 of any summons, order, or process in judicial proceedings, may be made either the day
1.22 before or the day after Thanksgiving Day, or such legal holiday. When the published notice
1.23 contains a description of real estate which is located within the legal limits of any city,
1.24 which city is situated in more than one county, such published notice may be published in

2.1 any legal newspaper within such city. Where the district court is required by rule or statute
2.2 to publish notice, summons, order, or other legal process of the district court, it may do so
2.3 by publishing on its own website in lieu of publishing in a qualified newspaper under
2.4 Minnesota Statutes, chapter 331A."
