Price has two components

- Recognized Tuition and Fees
- Living and Miscellaneous Expense Allowance

Minnesota Statute 136A.121 Subd. 6. Cost of attendance.

- (a) The recognized cost of attendance consists of:
 - (1) an allowance specified in law for living and miscellaneous expenses, and
 - (2) an allowance for tuition and fees equal to the lesser of the average tuition and fees charged by the institution, or a tuition and fee maximum if one is established in law. If no tuition and fee maximum is established in law, the allowance for tuition and fees is equal to the lesser of: (1) the average tuition and fees charged by the institution, and (2) for two-year programs, an amount equal to the highest tuition and fees charged at a public two-year institution, or for four-year programs, an amount equal to the highest tuition and fees charged at a public university.

 - \$6,113 Normandale Community College (2-Year)


Living and Miscellaneous Expenses

State Grant Formula – Set the Budget


Example - Dependent Student, Full-Time - University of Minnesota Twin Cities, 2020-2021



Recognized tuition and fees will vary based on actual tuition and fees charged and the institution type. Tuition and fees as recognized for State Grant purposes are capped at the highest priced two- and four-year institutions, though students may see a tuition bill that exceeds these caps.



Example - Dependent Student, Full-Time - University of Minnesota Twin Cities, 2020-2021



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


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


Family Adjusted Gross Income


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
Example - Dependent Student, Full-Time - Normandale Community College, 2020-2021




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
Example - Dependent Student, Full-Time – Average 4-Year Public University, 2020-2021





Federal Changes to Student Aid

Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021

- Spending bill passed at the end of the last calendar year
- Includes changes to the federal needs analysis that will impact Minnesota

FAFSA Simplification

- Number of questions on the FAFSA are reduced
- Creates more predictable eligibility for the Pell Grant
- Student Aid Index (SAI) vs Expected Family Contribution (EFC)
