

Subject Lights On grant program

Summary

This bill creates a Lights On grant program for vouchers that are provided to vehicle operators to replace or repair malfunctioning motor vehicle lights, including to set a \$250 voucher maximum, establish program eligibility for political subdivisions and local law enforcement agencies, specify an application process, identify prioritization for grants, and require an annual report. It appropriates \$1.2 million from the Highway User Tax Distribution Fund to the Department of Public Safety in fiscal year 2025 for the program and sets an annual base of \$1.2 million in the tails (fiscal years 2026 and 2027).
