

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 958, in conference committee, as follows:

1.2 On R27, Senate language, (S0958-3)

1.3 Page 21, delete section 3 and insert:

1.4 "Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 18B.33, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.5 Subdivision 1. **Requirement.** (a) A person may not apply a pesticide for hire without a
1.6 commercial applicator license for the appropriate use categories or a structural pest control
1.7 license.

1.8 (b) A commercial applicator licensee must have a valid license identification card to
1.9 purchase a restricted use pesticide or apply pesticides for hire and must display it upon
1.10 demand by an authorized representative of the commissioner or a law enforcement officer.
1.11 The commissioner shall prescribe the information required on the license identification
1.12 card.

1.13 (c) A person licensed under this section is considered qualified and is not required to
1.14 verify, document, or otherwise prove a particular need prior to use, except as required by
1.15 the federal label.

1.16 (d) A person who uses a general-use sanitizer or disinfectant for hire in response to
1.17 COVID-19 is exempt from the commercial applicator license requirements under this section.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective retroactively from March 31, 2021."
