1.8	Subd. 1a. Setbacks; solar energy generating systems. A permit must not be granted
1.9	under this chapter to construct a solar energy generating system that is located within
1.10	three-quarters of a mile of:
1.11	(1) a state park, as defined in section 86A.05, subdivision 2;
1.12	(2) a state wildlife management area, as defined in section 86A.05, subdivision 8; or
1.13	(3) a county park.
1.14	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment and
1.15	applies to all solar energy generating systems applying for a site permit under Minnesota
1.16	Statutes, chapter 216I, on or after that date.
