"Sec. 20. SHORT-CALL SUBSTITUTE TEACHER PILOT.

Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.18, subdivision 7a, the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board may allow a person who meets the professional requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.181, subdivision 2, paragraph (b), to be employed as a short-call substitute teacher in any content area, not only career and technical education. The board must obtain a criminal history background check on all first-time applicants in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.181, subdivision 8. A short-call substitute teacher must comply with the code of ethics and the board may suspend or revoke a short-call substitute teacher license if the teacher violates the code of ethics.
