# **The Equity Fund**

Our vision is a vibrant, diverse business community that encourages and supports LGBTQ+ entrepreneurs and small businesses.

The Equity Fund is an innovative program that invests in LGBTO+ small businesses through grants and programing tailored to the unique needs of LGBTQ+ entrepreneurs. To date, the Equity Fund has invested more than \$185,000 and provided business education to queer businesses in Minnesota.

LGBTQ+ businesses make up more than 7% of the total business landscape. Despite their significant contributions to the economy, LGBTQ+ entrepreneurs face unique challenges in gaining access to capital and business development support. The Equity Fund helps even the playing field and invests in Minnesota as a whole.

#### Our ask:

- \$500,000 per fiscal year (FY24 &FY25) to be appropriated to DEED.
- Funds will be used for LGBTQ+ small business grants and business education and support.
- 1/3 of funds earmarked for LGBTQ+ businesses from Greater Minnesota and 1/3 for LGBTQ+ businesses owned by entrepreneurs of color.

The Equity Fund aims to make Minnesota a vibrant state where all businesses can thrive. The fund was born out of an urgent need to support LGBTQ+ entrepreneurs of color who were disproportionately impacted by the pandemic and local civil unrest. Nearly one-third of LGBTQ+ small business owners say they lost 50% of their business as a result of COVID.

A 2021 study\* conducted by the Center for LGBTQ Economic Advancement & Research found that 28% of LGBTQ small businesses reported having poor financial health; additionally, business owners reported a lower likelihood of receiving financing due to their LGBTQ+ identity.

The pandemic shined a light on longtime, systemic challenges faced by LGBTQ+ entrepreneurs. That's why the Equity Fund has continued and grown beyond the initial need.

### **PFund Foundation**

Since 1987, PFund Foundation has been the upper Midwest's only LGBTQ+ community foundation. PFund awards scholarships and grants, develops leaders, and inspires philanthropy. It has awarded more than \$3.5 million dollars to LGBTQ+ communities. PFund Foundation is led by the community, in support of the community.

### **Accomplishments**

- 500 LGBTQ+ students have been awarded more than \$1.5 million in scholarships.
- \$125,000 was awarded in 2022 for ruralserving LGBTQ+ organizations across the upper Midwest.
- Mobilized more than \$250,000 in emergency funds for families, nonprofits, and small businesses during the pandemic.



### Quorum

Quorum is the LGBTQ+ and allied chamber of Commerce for Minnesota. Quorum champions the business case for a fully-inclusive business community as a conduit for economic development and is a leader in the continuum of change. Quorum builds, connects and strengthens Minnesota's LGBTQ+ and allied business communities.

- Provided 550+ hours of networking and small business education to over 1200 entrepreneurs since 2019.
- Hosts more than 70+ networking, education and certification events throughout the year.
- Is the statewide faciltator for LGBTQ Business Enterprise Certification.
