EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

The proposal would require schools and charter schools that offer or provide group health insurance to complete an annual survey from the Legislative Budget Office. The survey would include information regarding group health insurance plans. The Legislative Budget Office would compile information from the surveys and provide a report each year to the legislature.

The proposal would also provide an administrative appropriation to the Legislative Budget Office to complete the annual report. The appropriation amounts are blank.

REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL

- The appropriation provided to the Legislative Budget Office would increase costs to the state general fund by an unknown amount beginning in fiscal year 2027.
