1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 62E.23, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.4 to read:

1.5 Subd. 2a. **Payment parameters.** The payment parameters shall be based on the rating
1.6 of an enrollee's health plan according to the National Committee for Quality Assurance
1.7 (NCQA). The payment parameters for 2022 and all future years are set as follows.

1.8 (a) For health plans with a NCQA star rating of 5, the attachment point is \$40,000, the
1.9 coinsurance rate is 84 percent, and the reinsurance cap is \$270,000.

1.10 (b) For health plans with a NCQA star rating of 4.5, the attachment point is \$45,000,
1.11 the coinsurance rate is 82 percent, and the reinsurance cap is \$260,000.

1.12 (c) For health plans with a NCQA star rating of 4, the attachment point is \$50,000, the
1.13 coinsurance rate is 80 percent, and the reinsurance cap is \$250,000.

1.14 (d) For health plans with a NCQA star rating of 3.5, the attachment point is \$55,000,
1.15 the coinsurance rate is 78 percent, and the reinsurance cap is \$240,000.

1.16 (e) For health plans with a NCQA star rating of 3, the attachment point is \$60,000, the
1.17 coinsurance rate is 76 percent, and the reinsurance cap is \$230,000.

1.18 (f) For health plans with a NCQA star rating of 2.5, the attachment point is \$65,000, the
1.19 coinsurance rate is 74 percent, and the reinsurance cap is \$220,000.

1.20 (g) For health plans with a NCQA star rating of 2, the attachment point is \$70,000, the
1.21 coinsurance rate is 72 percent, and the reinsurance cap is \$210,000.

1.22 (h) For health plans with a NCQA star rating of 1.5, the attachment point is \$75,000,
1.23 the coinsurance rate is 70 percent, and the reinsurance cap is \$200,000.

2.1 (i) For health plans with a NCQA star rating of 1, the attachment point is \$80,000, the
2.2 coinsurance rate is 68 percent, and the reinsurance cap is \$190,000."

2.4 "Sec. 4. **REPEALER.**
