1.2 Page 1, delete section 1

1.3 Page 2, delete sections 2 and 3 and insert:

1.4 "Section 1. **VIOLENT CRIME REDUCTION AND CLEARANCE SUPPORT;**
1.5 **SPECIAL REVENUE ACCOUNT; APPROPRIATION.**

1.6 (a) The violent crime reduction and clearance support account is created in the special
1.7 revenue fund consisting of money deposited, donated, allotted, transferred, or otherwise
1.8 provided to the account. Of the amount in the account, up to \$15,000,000 each year is
1.9 appropriated to the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to support violent crime reduction
1.10 strategies. This includes funding for staff and supplies to enhance forensic, analytical, and
1.11 investigations capacity, and financially support investigative partnerships with other law
1.12 enforcement agencies to conduct forensic and investigatory work to expedite clearance
1.13 rates.

1.14 (b) Funds allocated shall be used where there is the most acute need for supplemental
1.15 resources based on the rate of violent crime and the need to improve clearance rates for
1.16 violent crime investigations. The superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension
1.17 shall prioritize allocating resources to political subdivisions that have recorded at least three
1.18 violent crimes in the previous fiscal year and that rank in the 20 highest per capita crime
1.19 rates among Minnesota political subdivisions in the previous fiscal year based on the Uniform
1.20 Crime Reports or National Incident Based Reporting System. As a condition of receiving
1.21 investigatory assistance from the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension from this account, the
1.22 local unit of government must enter a joint powers agreement with the commissioner of
1.23 Public Safety and the superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension.

2.1 (c) By December 15 of each calendar year, the commissioner shall report to the chairs
2.2 and ranking minority members of the legislative committees and divisions with jurisdiction
2.3 over public safety finance and policy on how funds in the violent crime reduction and
2.4 clearance support account were used. Each report must, at a minimum, summarize the
2.5 expenditures made, indicate the purpose of those expenditures, and provide an overview of
2.6 the criminal cases where funds from the account were used, including a summary of the
2.7 cases that identifies each case's disposition or outcome.

2.8 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

2.9 **Sec. 2. VIOLENT CRIME REDUCTION AND CLEARANCE SUPPORT**
2.10 **ACCOUNT; TRANSFER.**

2.11 \$75,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is transferred from the general fund to the violent crime
2.12 reduction and clearance support account in the special revenue fund. The base for this
2.13 appropriation is \$0 in fiscal year 2024 and thereafter.

2.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."

2.15 Page 4, line 12, delete "or process evidence"

2.16 Page 5, after line 3, insert:

2.17 "Sec. 8. **REPEALER.**

2.18 Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 299C.80, subdivision 7, is repealed."

2.19 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

2.20 Amend the title accordingly
