1.6 Subd. 3a. **Required service components.** (a) Intensive nonresidential rehabilitative
1.7 mental health services, supports, and ancillary activities that are covered by a single daily
1.8 rate per client must include the following, as needed by the individual client:

1.9 (1) individual, family, and group psychotherapy;

1.10 (2) individual, family, and group skills training, as defined in section 256B.0943,
1.11 subdivision 1, paragraph (r);

1.12 (3) crisis planning as defined in section 245.4871, subdivision 9a;

1.13 (4) medication management provided by a ~~physician, an advanced practice registered~~
1.14 ~~nurse with certification in psychiatric and mental health care, or a physician assistant~~ qualified
1.15 provider;

1.16 (5) mental health case management as provided in section 256B.0625, subdivision 20;

1.17 (6) medication education services as defined in this section;

1.18 (7) care coordination by a client-specific lead worker assigned by and responsible to the
1.19 treatment team;

1.20 (8) psychoeducation of and consultation and coordination with the client's biological,
1.21 adoptive, or foster family and, in the case of a youth living independently, the client's
1.22 immediate nonfamilial support network;

2.1 (9) clinical consultation to a client's employer or school or to other service agencies or
2.2 to the courts to assist in managing the mental illness or co-occurring disorder and to develop
2.3 client support systems;

2.4 (10) coordination with, or performance of, crisis intervention and stabilization services
2.5 as defined in section 256B.0624;

2.6 (11) transition services;

2.7 (12) co-occurring substance use disorder treatment as defined in section 245I.02,
2.8 subdivision 11; and

2.9 (13) housing access support that assists clients to find, obtain, retain, and move to safe
2.10 and adequate housing. Housing access support does not provide monetary assistance for
2.11 rent, damage deposits, or application fees.

2.12 (b) The provider shall ensure and document the following by means of performing the
2.13 required function or by contracting with a qualified person or entity: client access to crisis
2.14 intervention services, as defined in section 256B.0624, and available 24 hours per day and
2.15 seven days per week."

2.16 Page 39, line 19, strike ", or" and insert a semicolon

2.17 Page 39, line 20, before the period, insert "; or (3) if a treatment team demonstrates to
2.18 the commissioner expertise in meeting the developmental and clinical needs of an expanded
2.19 age range, at least eight years of age and under 21 years of age"

2.20 Page 39, line 30, strike everything after "(ii)"

2.21 Page 39, line 31, strike the old language

2.22 Page 39, strike line 32 and insert "a psychiatric care provider who is credentialed to
2.23 prescribe medications and is either an advanced practice registered nurse with advanced
2.24 education and training in psychiatric and mental health care or a board-certified psychiatrist.
2.25 The psychiatric care provider must have demonstrated clinical experience and qualifications
2.26 for working with children and adolescents with serious mental illness and co-occurring
2.27 mental illness and substance use disorders;"
