

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PERPICH CENTER FOR ARTS EDUCATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS & GOVERNANCE


- Minnesota's state agency dedicated to arts education
- The Board consists of 16 members, including the Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Education or the Commissioner's designee
 - Willie Jett, ex officio member (Assistant Commissioner, Bobbie Burnham, currently serving as designee)
- 15 members appointed by the Governor, confirmed by the Senate
- At least one member must be from each congressional district
- No member may serve for more than two consecutive terms
- MN Dept. of Management and Budget provides management services
- MN Dept. of Education collaborates on arts education and professional development
- Minnesota Statute Chapter 129c: Perpich Center for Arts Education

BUDGET

- Current Biennial Appropriation for Perpich: \$14,933,000
- FY22 \$7,406,000
- FY23 \$7,527,000
- Base Appropriation for Upcoming Biennium: \$15,064,000

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- FY24 \$7,532,000
- FY25 \$7,532,000




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
BUDGET CONT.

- Perpich Center had a total biennial budget of \$15 million
- Funds are primarily from general fund appropriations

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 Perpich Center also receives revenues from student fees and federal reimbursements through the MN Department of Education





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OUR UNIQUE ROLE – ARTS HIGH SCHOOL

- Minnesota's only residential arts high school
- Students from all over the state (36 of 87 counties, 101 high schools represented)
- Access to a high quality, arts-infused education
- Students immersed in a community of artistically talented and passionate peers
- College prep program is not only found in our academic offerings, but also our artistic skill development and the residential community we provide

OUR UNIQUE ROLE – PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT & RESOURCE PROGRAMS (PDR)

- Goal of PDR is to build teacher and administrator capacity statewide so they can provide innovative, inclusive, standards-based, measurable, and student-centered learning in and through the arts
- Serve the work of Minnesota fine arts educators and administrators through dynamic face-to-face and online workshops, consultation, and professional development customized to school or district needs. A major focus of their work is on implementation of the 2018 Minnesota Academic Standards in the Arts.
- Regional Centers program includes: Classroom Visits/Peer Observations and Regional Arts Teacher-Leader (RAT-L) network. Regional Workshops have been replaced by our virtual workshops.
- Comprehensive Arts Planning Program (CAPP) provides strategic planning for school districts to help them create multi-year strategic plans to guide local and district decision-making related to arts education

OUR UNIQUE ROLE – LIBRARY

- Perpich Arts Library is a resource for Perpich Arts High School students and the Minnesota public
- Any resident of Minnesota can join the library for free and gain access to our extensive arts education resources
 - Access and support for Minnesota's arts educators
- All Perpich Arts High School students can use the library as a resource for materials and research projects, technology, study space, etc.

PDR BY THE NUMBERS

- 1. The number of Minnesota senate districts served: **67 of 67**. The number of contacts with educators/administrators in each senate district ranged from **12 to 439**.
- 2. The number of Minnesota charter schools/school districts served: 222.
- 3. The number of educators/administrators served: **1,229**, and they each attended an average of **1.7** professional development events.
- 4. The number of PDR outreach events: **383**. This is the same number as FY21, and PDR staff was able to use what they learned during the pandemic to provide more varied support during FY22.
- The number of school districts completing Year 1 of the Comprehensive Arts Planning Program (CAPP): 8 of 8.
- 6. The number of professional development events led by Regional Arts Teacher-Leaders: 20.





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PERPICH ARTS HIGH SCHOOL ACADEMIC, INTENSIVE TRAINING IN THE Arts

- A comprehensive, tuition free, public high school for 11th and 12th grade students throughout Minnesota
- Arts High School offers a rigorous academic program
- Intensive coursework focused on six art areas: Dance, Literary Arts, Media Arts, Music, Theater (Musical Theater track), and Visual Arts
- No cost for qualifying students to live in Residential Hall (residence 20 miles or more from campus, outside of Hennepin & Ramsey Counties)

ARTS HIGH SCHOOL BY THE NUMBERS

- 1. 2022 Graduation Rate was 100%
- 2. 62% of Class of 2022 enrolled in Post-Secondary for Fall, 2022
- 3. 45% commuters; 55% dorm residents
- 4. 61% of student body from 7-County Metro Area; 39% of student body from Outstate MN
 - 1. Note: Overall MN Student Distribution 56% County Metro 44% Outstate (Source: MDE)
- 5. Enrolled students on Day 1 of the 2022-23 school year: 154
- 6. Congressional District Representation: 8 of 8
- 7. Representation in the Minnesota Legislature:
 - 1. House Districts: 63%
 - 2. Senate Districts: 82%
