

1.1 Senator moves to amend H.F. No. 2887, in conference committee, as
1.2 follows:

1.3 On Transportation Part D, R54, Senate language (UEH2887-2)

1.4 Page 170, delete section 49 and insert:

1.5 "Sec. 49. [219.752] MINIMUM CREW SIZE.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Class I or Class II railroad. A Class I railroad or Class II railroad must
1.7 not operate a train or light engine used in connection with the movement of freight unless
1.8 it has a crew of a minimum of two individuals.

1.9 Subd. 2. Class III railroad. (a) For purposes of this subdivision, "shared corridor" means
1.10 a segment of railroad track in which light rail transit operates within or adjacent to
1.11 right-of-way used in freight rail operation.

1.12 (b) A Class III railroad while operating in a shared corridor must not operate a train or
1.13 light engine used in connection with the movement of freight unless it has a crew of a
1.14 minimum of two individuals.

1.15 Subd. 3. Exemption. The requirements of this section do not apply to hostler services
1.16 or utility employees.

1.17 Subd. 4. Penalty; action. (a) Any railroad that willfully violates this section must pay
1.18 a fine of not less than \$250 or more than \$1,000 for a first offense, not less than \$1,000 or
1.19 more than \$5,000 for a second offense committed within three years of the first offense,
1.20 and not less than \$5,000 nor more than \$10,000 for a third or subsequent offense committed
1.21 within three years of the first offense.

1.22 (b) Fines prescribed in this section must be recovered in a civil action before a judge of
1.23 the county in which the violation occurs.

1.24 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective 30 days following final enactment."
