Thank you for your time today and your work in Higher Education for our great state of Minnesota.

As the number of young adults with autism and learning disabilities rapidly increases (138% increase in MN Public Schools since 2009), now is a critical time to expand MICC's programming to serve more individuals and to keep our programming affordable for Minnesota Family's at all income levels.

Please support adding additional funding to MICC and be a voice for young adults that require a different educational pathway to success.
