2.7 within the third degree of kindred according to the rules of civil law. A registration to possess
2.8 farmed white-tailed may be sold or transferred only once under this paragraph. Before the
2.9 board approves a sale or transfer under this paragraph, the board must verify that the farmed
2.10 white-tailed deer herd is free from chronic wasting disease and the person or eligible family
2.11 member must pay a onetime transfer fee of \$500 to the board."
