Summary

This bill broadens the disclosure of motor vehicle crash reports produced by law enforcement officers following a collision, which are generally limited to a specified set of circumstances. Under the change, the Department of Public Safety or a law enforcement agency must disclose the report on request of a local prosecutor who is involved in an implied consent case with a traffic or criminal offense that is identified as a result of a traffic crash investigation by law enforcement. It is effective August 1, 2021.
