1.3 Page 5, after line 6, insert:

1.4 "Sec. 6. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 168.27, subdivision 24, is amended to read:

1.5 Subd. 24. **Bonds.** (a) Except as otherwise provided in this subdivision, all persons  
1.6 licensed according to this section shall keep in full force and effect a bond with a corporate  
1.7 surety to be approved by the registrar of motor vehicles in the following amounts; in the  
1.8 case of boat trailer, snowmobile trailer, or horse trailer ~~or motorized bicycle~~ dealers, or  
1.9 dealers in trailers with a manufacturer's rated carrying capacity under 15,000 pounds designed  
1.10 to transport small construction or farm equipment, in the amount of \$5,000; and as to all  
1.11 other persons in the amount of \$50,000. The bond must be conditioned on the faithful  
1.12 performance by the licensee of the obligations imposed on persons engaged in motor vehicle  
1.13 transactions by the laws of this state, including the conduct required of a licensee by this  
1.14 section and other sections governing the sale or transfer of motor vehicles, and the payment  
1.15 of all taxes, license fees, and penalties. The bond must be for the benefit of the state of  
1.16 Minnesota and any transferor, seller, or purchaser of a motor vehicle for any monetary loss  
1.17 caused by failure of the licensee to meet the obligations enumerated above. Proceedings on  
1.18 the forfeiture of the bonds must be commenced in the district court of the county wherein  
1.19 the business of the licensed person was carried on, or if in more than one county, the county  
1.20 in which the offense occurred. This subdivision does not apply to a used vehicle parts dealer  
1.21 or a scrap metal processor.

1.22 (b) This subdivision does not apply to:

2.1 (1) a dealer in new trailers designed to transport small construction or farm equipment  
2.2 in any year following a year in which the dealer had less than \$500,000 in gross receipts  
2.3 from the sale of such trailers; or

2.4 (2) a dealer in new trailers designed to transport small construction or farm equipment  
2.5 who has been a dealer in such trailers for less than one year and who the department  
2.6 reasonably determines will have gross receipts of less than \$500,000 during the first year  
2.7 of business."

2.8 Page 6, line 12, after "bicycle" insert a colon and insert:

2.9 "(1)"

2.10 Page 6, line 14, delete the period and insert "; or"

2.11 Page 6, after line 14, insert:

2.12 "(2) has been certified by the vehicle manufacturer for compliance with SAE International  
2.13 standard J2929 or a similar applicable electrical safety standard approved by the  
2.14 commissioner of public safety."

2.15 Page 6, line 18, delete everything after "by" and insert "the vehicle manufacturer for  
2.16 compliance with: (1) the latest revision of SAE International standard J2929; or (2) a similar  
2.17 applicable standard from SAE International, International Organization for Standardization  
2.18 (ISO), United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE), or International  
2.19 Electrotechnical Commission (IEC), or another electrical safety standard. A standard under  
2.20 clause (2) must be approved by the commissioner of public safety."

2.21 Page 6, delete lines 19 and 20

2.22 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

2.23 Amend the title accordingly
