1.4 Subd. 1a. **NETStudy 2.0 system.** (a) The commissioner shall design, develop, and test
1.5 the NETStudy 2.0 system and implement it no later than September 1, 2015.

1.6 (b) The NETStudy 2.0 system developed and implemented by the commissioner shall
1.7 incorporate and meet all applicable data security standards and policies required by the
1.8 Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal
1.9 Apprehension, and the Office of MN.IT Services. The system shall meet all required
1.10 standards for encryption of data at the database level as well as encryption of data that
1.11 travels electronically among agencies initiating background studies, the commissioner's
1.12 authorized fingerprint collection vendor, the commissioner, the Bureau of Criminal
1.13 Apprehension, and in cases involving national criminal record checks, the FBI.

1.14 (c) The data system developed and implemented by the commissioner shall incorporate
1.15 a system of data security that allows the commissioner to control access to the data field
1.16 level by the commissioner's employees. The commissioner shall establish that employees
1.17 have access to the minimum amount of private data on any individual as is necessary to
1.18 perform their duties under this chapter. The data system must record in a data audit trail all
1.19 queries and responses affecting data on individuals, and all actions in which data on
1.20 individuals are entered, updated, accessed, shared, or disseminated. When data on individuals
1.21 is disseminated outside of the Department of Human Services, the data audit trail must
1.22 record the government entity or person who received the data. Data contained in the audit
1.23 trail that identify individuals are classified as private data on individuals. The audit trail
1.24 must also be available in a public format that does not identify individuals or include other
1.25 information that could uniquely identify an individual.
