Summary

This bill requires chief law enforcement officers to share, in real time, certain private peace officer data with the POST Board in order for the board to evaluate the effectiveness of required training, to assist the Ensuring Police Excellence and Improving Community Relations Advisory Council in fulfilling the council's duties, and to enable the board and advisory council to identify patterns of behavior that suggest an officer is in crisis or is likely to violate a board-mandated model policy.
