# “The Why” for Our Community

Rural residents are **older and sicker**, and at greater risk of chronic diseases and **have less access to health care**.

Of the 8,300 health professional shortage areas (primary care):

- 2 of 3 are in rural areas
- 219 are in Minnesota
- Pediatricians, Psychiatrists, General Surgeons, and Obstetrics/Gynecology are in short supply

**The median age of Rural Minnesota physicians is 58 and 33% plan to leave the profession within 5 years**

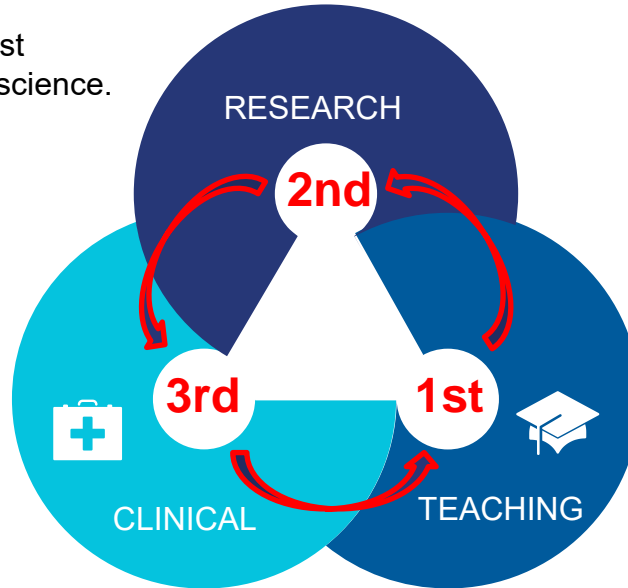

# \$10M State Grant Appropriation

## Funding guidelines:

*“\$10,000,000 the first year is for programs at the University of Minnesota Medical School Campus on the CentraCare Health System Campus in St. Cloud. This appropriation may be used for tuition support, including a scholarship program targeted at students who will practice in rural areas and targeted at students from diverse backgrounds; costs associated with opening and operating a new regional campus; costs associated with the expansion of a residency program; and costs associated with starting and operating a rural health research program. This appropriation is available until June 30, 2027, and must be spent on for activities on or associated with the CentraCare Health System Campus in the greater St. Cloud area. This is a onetime appropriation.”<sup>1</sup>*

## Grant Fund Oversight

- Budget plan and proposed spending from the grant are the responsibility of the RHAA Finance Subcommittee.
- Funds are held at the University and requests will be made on an annual basis in arrears for reimbursement of approved expenses.
- The first request for reimbursement will be made in July 2025, for expenses incurred in F2024 and F2025.

# RHAA Financial Operating Guidelines

- Leaders shall operate within the parameters of the budget endorsed by the Finance Committee and approved by the Governance Committee.
- The approved budget shall be comparable to the budgets of the Twin Cities and Duluth campuses, adjusted for differences in enrollment.
- The Academic Affiliation financial performance will be presented on a combined basis, including both University-based and CentraCare-based transactions.
- Any material changes shall be approved by the Dean of the Medical School and the CEO of CentraCare at the recommendation of the Governance Committee.
- Expenditures that will require endorsement by the Finance Committee and approval by the Governance Committee will include:
  - Any FTE additions or increases in FTE, regardless of whether they are in the budget
  - Current year expenses that cannot be covered within the approved budget and are in excess of 5% of the total budget.
  - Current year expenses that will also impact future years and are not in the pro forma F2026 budget.
  - Financing plans to offset the impact of compensation changes that were approved by Human Resources and Leadership

# \$10M State Grant Appropriation

## **Strategic priorities:**

- Regional Medical School:
  - Costs specific to opening the campus, such as LCME accreditation, promotional materials, recruitment of students & faculty, etc.
  - Salaries of CentraCare medical school administration
  - UMMS resources dedicated to the CentraCare campus project
  - Fund start-up costs, such as faculty hired before the school opens
  - Cost of training CentraCare physician preceptors
- Residency program:
  - Salaries and support costs for residency program administration
  - CentraCare physician preceptors' compensation & training costs
  - Residents' salaries & benefits not covered by MERC and DME
  - Facility renovations needed to expand key residency programs
- Scholarship funds not covered by philanthropy
- Research Institute:
  - Salaries & support costs for CentraCare research administration
  - UMMS resources dedicated/allocated to the CentraCare Rural Research Institute
  - Potential consulting costs to create the Rural Research Institute organizational and governance structure

# Detailed planned spending (F2026-F2027)

## F2026 grant spend, totaling \$5,851,164 will include:

- \$533,333 in scholarships (consistent with other campus scholarship programs)
- \$2,497,997 UME programmatic deficit
- \$1,932,834 for facility renovation needed to expand Family Medicine residency program
- \$1,000,000 in start-up costs for Research program at CentraCare Campus, to fund salaries and support need to stand up a research institute as well as UMMS resources dedicated to the CentraCare Research Institute.

## F2027 grant spend, totaling \$2,100,000 will include:

- \$1,066,667 in scholarships (consistent with other campus scholarship programs)
- \$533,333 UME programmatic deficit
- \$500,000 in start-up costs for Research program at CentraCare Campus, to fund salaries and support need to stand up a research institute as well as UMMS resources dedicated to the CentraCare Research Institute.
