1.6 Section 1. DIRECTION TO THE COMMISSIONER OF CHILDREN, YOUTH,  
1.7 AND FAMILIES; CRISIS NURSERY LICENSING.

1.8 The commissioner of children, youth, and families must develop a licensing framework  
1.9 for crisis nurseries. The framework must include pathways for organizations to become  
1.10 licensed crisis nurseries, a definition for crisis nurseries, background study and training  
1.11 requirements, and ways to reduce redundancy and resolve conflicting requirements between  
1.12 Minnesota Rules, parts 2960.0510 to 2960.0530, 2960.3000 to 2960.3100, and chapter 9502,  
1.13 and Minnesota Statutes, chapter 142B. In developing the framework, the commissioner  
1.14 must work with stakeholders seeking to develop a crisis nursery license. By January 15,  
1.15 2028, the commissioner must submit a report to the chairs and ranking minority members  
1.16 of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over children, youth, and families licensing.  
1.17 The report must contain an overview of the licensing framework, a detailed explanation of  
1.18 the framework, and proposed legislation to make any statutory changes that are needed to  
1.19 implement the new license for crisis nurseries."

1.21 Page 117, after line 32, insert:

2.1 \$250,000 in fiscal year 2027 is for grants to  
 2.2 provide training scholarships for recipients to  
 2.3 attend nationally recognized forensic interview  
 2.4 protocol training. Eligible grantees must award  
 2.5 scholarships for recipients to attend basic  
 2.6 forensic interview training, advanced forensic  
 2.7 interview training, and specialized interview  
 2.8 topics training. Scholarship recipients may  
 2.9 include individuals in law enforcement, child  
 2.10 protection, and prosecution; health  
 2.11 professionals investigating, treating, and  
 2.12 managing child maltreatment cases in  
 2.13 Minnesota; advocates working with a  
 2.14 multidisciplinary team; and forensic  
 2.15 interviewers at children's advocacy centers.
