Chair Liebling and members of the Committee,

I am submitting this written testimony as a private individual and not representing any organization. I am in favor of this bill; MA enrollees should have the “Freedom to Choose” their health care providers and not be forced into a managed care arrangement by DHS. MA enrollees are capable of making their own health care decisions to manage their health care.

As a Federal and Minnesota taxpayer who funds MA, it is my opinion that passing this bill will reduce existing racial disparities in health care. Somehow DHS and the managed care plans have forgotten over the years that the “right to choose your health care provider” is a “right of personal responsibility”.
