Dear Chair Liebling and Members of the Committee:

Minnesota's Prenatal to Three Coalition (PN-3) requests your support for HF 1268. The PN-3 Coalition advocates for equitable state policies to support strong families and give children the best start in life and we believe HF 1268 provides important resources and training that can save lives. Unfortunately, in Minnesota maternal death rates are 2-3 times higher for Black, American-born African American women and Indigenous women, regardless of income and education¹ and many families experience ongoing stress related to housing and economic stability that has long term negative health impacts.

The Minnesota Department of Health recently completed their Maternal and Child Health needs as part of the federal Title V funding. A key finding focuses on improving culturally responsive care to women and families.² The needs assessment acknowledges that culture plays a huge role in how women and families define health and how they interact with the health care system.

The African American Babies Coalition (AABC) at Wilder works with families and communities to increase awareness about brain development and its impact on the long-term health and development of children. AABC provides families with critical training opportunities with trusted community partners. AABC works with other Integrated Care for High Risk Pregnancy (ICHRP) partners to connect families to health resources to positively impact health and mental health outcomes for Moms, babies and their family.
