1.3 "Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 201.054, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 2. **Prohibitions; penalty; affirmative defense.** (a) No individual shall  
1.5 intentionally:

1.6 (a) (1) cause or attempt to cause the individual's name to be registered in any  
1.7 precinct if the individual is not eligible to vote;

1.8 (b) (2) cause or attempt to cause the individual's name to be registered for the  
1.9 purpose of voting in more than one precinct;

1.10 (c) (3) misrepresent the individual's identity when attempting to register to vote; or

1.11 (d) (4) aid, abet, counsel, or procure any other individual to violate this subdivision.

1.12 A violation of this subdivision is a felony.

1.13 (b) It is an affirmative defense to a prosecution for violation of paragraph (a), clause  
1.14 (1), if the individual:

1.15 (1) requested, in writing, that the county auditor of the county where the individual  
1.16 resides withdraw the registration, and the request was made before any complaint was  
1.17 filed alleging a violation of paragraph (a), clause (1); and

1.18 (2) did not vote at an election between the time the registration application was  
1.19 submitted and the time the individual requested the registration be withdrawn."
