1.2 Page 2, after line 21, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 2. [16.0466] STATE AGENCY TECHNOLOGY PROJECTS.

1.4 Every state agency with an information or telecommunications project must consult
1.5 with the Office of Enterprise Technology to determine what the IT cost of the project is, and
1.6 transfer the IT cost portion to the Office of Enterprise Technology, unless the commissioner
1.7 of the Office of Enterprise Technology determines that a transfer is not required."

1.8 Page 7, after line 26, insert:

1.9 "Sec. 10. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 16E.07, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.10 Subd. 6. **Fees.** The office shall establish fees for technical and transaction services
1.11 for government units through North Star. Fees must be credited to the North Star account.
1.12 Except for the convenience fee under subdivision 12, the office may not charge a fee for
1.13 viewing or inspecting data made available through North Star or linked facilities, unless
1.14 specifically authorized by law.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2013.

1.16 Sec. 11. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 16E.07, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.17 to read:

1.18 Subd. 12. **Private entity services; fee authority; council established.** (a) The
1.19 office may enter into a contract with a private entity to manage, maintain, support, and
1.20 expand North Star and online government information services to citizens and businesses.

1.21 (b) A contract established under paragraph (a) may provide for compensation of the
1.22 private entity through a fee established under paragraph (c).

1.23 (c) Upon authorization by the E-Government Advisory Council as created in
1.24 paragraph (e), a private entity that enters into a contract under paragraph (a) or the
1.25 office may establish a convenience fee for users of North Star and online government

2.1 information services up to a total of \$2 per transaction. A fee established under this
2.2 paragraph is in addition to any fees or surcharges authorized under other law.

2.3 (d) Receipts from the convenience fee shall be deposited in the North Star account
2.4 established in subdivision 7. Notwithstanding section 16A.1285, subdivision 2, receipts
2.5 credited to the account are appropriated to the office for payment to the contracted private
2.6 entity under paragraph (a). In lieu of depositing the receipts in the North Star account, the
2.7 office can directly transfer the receipts to the private entity or allow the private entity to
2.8 retain the receipts pursuant to a contract established under this subdivision.

2.9 (e) The E-Government Advisory Council is established for the purpose of improving
2.10 online government information services to citizens and businesses. The council shall
2.11 recommend to the office the priority of North Star projects and online government
2.12 information services to be developed and supported by convenience fee receipts. The
2.13 council shall provide oversight on the convenience fee and its receipts in the North Star
2.14 account. The council shall by majority quorum vote approve or disapprove establishing
2.15 the convenience fee on particular types of transactions, the fee amount, and any changes in
2.16 the fee amount. If the convenience fee receipts are retained by or transferred to the private
2.17 entity in lieu of deposit in the North Star account, the council may audit the private entity's
2.18 convenience fee receipts, expenses paid by the receipts, and associated financial statements.

2.19 (1) The council shall consist of the state chief information officer or the chief
2.20 information officer's designee, one member appointed by the speaker of the house, one
2.21 member appointed by the senate majority leader, and six members appointed by the
2.22 governor representing state executive branch agencies that are actively involved with
2.23 private businesses, the private business community, or the public.

2.24 (2) Membership terms, removal of member, and filling of vacancies are as provided
2.25 in section 15.059. Members do not receive compensation or reimbursement for expenses.

2.26 (3) The council shall select a chair from its members. The office shall provide
2.27 administrative support to the council.

2.28 (f) The office shall report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the house
2.29 of representatives and senate committees with jurisdiction over state government finance
2.30 by January 15 of each odd-numbered year regarding the convenience fee receipts and the
2.31 status of North Star projects and online government information services developed and
2.32 supported by convenience fee receipts."
