1.2 Page 3, line 16, after the semicolon insert "or"

1.3 Page 3, line 17, strike "; or" and insert a period

1.4 Page 3, delete line 18

1.5 Page 4, after line 35 insert:

1.6 "Sec. 5. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 203B.07, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Eligibility certificate.** A certificate of eligibility to vote by absentee ballot
1.8 shall be printed on the back of the return envelope. The certificate shall contain space for
1.9 the voter's Minnesota driver's license number, state identification number, or the last four
1.10 digits of the voter's Social Security number, ~~or to indicate that the voter does not have~~
1.11 ~~one of these numbers.~~ The space must be designed to ensure that the voter provides
1.12 the same type of identification as provided on the voter's absentee ballot application for
1.13 purposes of comparison. The certificate must also contain a statement to be signed and
1.14 sworn by the voter indicating that the voter meets all of the requirements established
1.15 by law for voting by absentee ballot and space for a statement signed by a person who
1.16 is registered to vote in Minnesota or by a notary public or other individual authorized
1.17 to administer oaths stating that:

1.18 (1) the ballots were displayed to that individual unmarked;

1.19 (2) the voter marked the ballots in that individual's presence without showing how
1.20 they were marked, or, if the voter was physically unable to mark them, that the voter
1.21 directed another individual to mark them; and

1.22 (3) if the voter was not previously registered, the voter has provided proof of
1.23 residence as required by section 201.061, subdivision 3."

1.24 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.25 Amend the title accordingly
