## "Section 1. <u>DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONERS; INCOME AND ASSET</u> EXCLUSION.

- (a) The commissioner of human services shall not count conditional cash transfers made to families participating in a family independence demonstration as income or assets for purposes of determining or redetermining eligibility for child care assistance programs under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 119B; general assistance under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 256D; group residential housing under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 256I; the Minnesota family investment program, work benefit program, or diversionary work program under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 256J; or the Minnesota Care program under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 256L, during the duration of the demonstration.
- (b) The commissioner of human services shall not count conditional cash transfers made to families participating in a family independence demonstration as income or assets for purposes of determining or redetermining eligibility for medical assistance, except that for enrollees subject to a modified adjusted gross income calculation to determine eligibility, the conditional cash transfer payments shall be counted as income if they are included on the enrollee's federal tax return as income or if the payments can be taken into account in the month of receipt as a lump sum payment.
- (c) The commissioner of the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency shall not count conditional cash transfers made to families participating in a family independence demonstration as income or assets for purposes of determining or redetermining eligibility for housing assistance programs under Minnesota Statutes, section 462A.201, during the duration of the demonstration.
