

1.1 ..... moves to amend H.F. No. 1239 as follows:

1.2 Page 18, after line 26, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 12. **[245A.1446] FAMILY CHILD CARE DIAPERING AREA**  
1.4 **DISINFECTION.**

1.5 Notwithstanding Minnesota Rules, part 9502.0435, a family child care provider may  
1.6 disinfect the diaper changing surface with either a solution of at least two teaspoons  
1.7 of chlorine bleach to one quart of water or with a surface disinfectant that meets the  
1.8 following criteria:

1.9 (1) the manufacturer's label or instructions states that the product is registered with  
1.10 the United States Environmental Protection Agency;

1.11 (2) the manufacturer's label or instructions state that the disinfectant is effective  
1.12 against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa;

1.13 (3) the manufacturer's label or instructions state that the disinfectant is effective with  
1.14 a ten minute or less contact time;

1.15 (4) the disinfectant is clearly labeled by the manufacturer with directions for mixing  
1.16 and use; and

1.17 (5) the disinfectant is used only in accordance with the manufacturer's directions."

1.18 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.19 Amend the title accordingly
