

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 1774, the third engrossment, as follows:

1.2 Page 2, lines 34 to 36, delete the new language and strike the existing language

1.3 Page 3, lines 1 to 16, delete the new language and strike the existing language

1.4 and insert:

1.5 "(c) A temporary or permanent structure used for the sale or display of consumer
1.6 fireworks, novelties, and sparkling devices must comply with National Fire Protection
1.7 Association Standard 1124 (2006 edition)."

1.8 Page 2, after line 18, insert:

1.9 "Sec. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 624.20, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.10 to read:

1.11 Subd. 1a. **Local regulation.** (a) A local unit of government may impose an annual
1.12 license fee for the retail sale of consumer fireworks, novelties and sparkling devices. The
1.13 annual license fee imposed on a retail seller that is in the business of selling only consumer
1.14 fireworks, novelties, and sparkling devices must not exceed \$350. The annual license
1.15 fee imposed on any other retail seller of consumer fireworks, novelties, and sparkling
1.16 devices must not exceed \$100.

1.17 (b) A local unit of government may enact an ordinance that is more restrictive than
1.18 state law and may prohibit or regulate the storage, sale, possession or use of consumer
1.19 fireworks, novelties or sparkling devices. An ordinance to regulate the storage, sale,
1.20 possession or use must be reasonable and provide for protection of the general health,
1.21 safety and welfare of the residents."

1.22 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.23 Amend the title accordingly
