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Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

"Section 1. APPROPRIATION; HOMEOWNERSHIP PROGRAM FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES.

- (a) \$1,200,000 in fiscal year 2015 is appropriated from the general fund to the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency for grants for families with children with disabilities to obtain homeownership. Eligible families must (1) have one child under the age of 19 with a medically diagnosed disability, and (2) have faced housing instability as renters due to the child's disability in the last two years requiring them to move or be at risk of losing their current housing.
- (b) Of the amount in paragraph (a), \$600,000 is to the City of Lakes Community

 Land Trust as a pilot project to provide homeownership opportunities to eligible low and

 moderate-income families to find safe and stable housing in conjunction with existing

 programs and provide additional financing assistance and incentives to families eligible

 under this section to make homeownership more affordable.
- (c) Of the amount in paragraph (a), \$600,000 is to the Housing Finance Agency for a pilot project to provide grants to nonprofit housing organizations and housing developers to provide home design, construction, and renovation to allow eligible low and moderate-income families to modify, improve, or build homes that are safe and accessible for families with children with disabilities.
- (d) Unexpended grant funds from fiscal year 2015 are available in fiscal year 2016."
