Subd. 6b. Collaborative management. "Collaborative management" is a mutually agreed upon plan between a graduate nurse practitioner or graduate clinical nurse specialist or clinical nurse specialist who qualifies for licensure as an advanced practice registered nurse and one or more physicians or surgeons licensed under chapter 147 or one or more advanced practice registered nurses licensed under chapter 148 that designates the scope of collaboration necessary to manage the care of patients. The graduate advanced practice registered nurse and the one or more physicians or one or more licensed advanced practice registered nurses must have experience in providing care to patients with the same or similar medical problems.

A graduate nurse practitioner or graduate clinical nurse specialist who qualifies for licensure as an advanced practice registered nurse must practice for at least 4,000 hours within the context of collaborative management or must be employed by a clinic or hospital that has a medical director who is a licensed physician. The graduate nurse practitioner or graduate clinical nurse specialist shall submit written evidence to the board upon completion of the required collaborative management clinical experience."
