1.5 Subd. 28a. **Licensed physician assistant services.** (a) Medical assistance covers
1.6 services performed by a licensed physician assistant if the service is otherwise covered
1.7 under this chapter as a physician service and if the service is within the scope of practice
1.8 of a licensed physician assistant as defined in section 147A.09.

1.9 (b) Licensed physician assistants, who are supervised by a physician certified by
1.10 the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or eligible for board certification in
1.11 psychiatry, may bill for medication management services provided to medical assistance
1.12 enrollees, consistent with their authorized scope of practice, in the following settings:
1.13 inpatient hospital, hospital-based outpatient behavioral health clinics, comprehensive
1.14 community mental health centers, and federally qualified health centers."
