1.5 Subd. 28a. **Licensed physician assistant services.** (a) Medical assistance covers  
1.6 services performed by a licensed physician assistant if the service is otherwise covered  
1.7 under this chapter as a physician service and if the service is within the scope of practice  
1.8 of a licensed physician assistant as defined in section 147A.09.

1.9 (b) Licensed physician assistants, who are supervised by a physician certified by  
1.10 the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or eligible for board certification  
1.11 in psychiatry, may bill for medication management and evaluation and management  
1.12 services provided to medical assistance enrollees in inpatient hospital settings and they  
1.13 may also bill for these services provided in outpatient settings after the physician assistant  
1.14 has completed 4,000 hours of on-site clinical supervision in the treatment of child and  
1.15 adolescent mental illness and disorders, consistent with their authorized scope of practice,  
1.16 as defined in section 147A.09, with the exception of performing psychotherapy or  
1.17 diagnostic assessments or providing clinical supervision."
