

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 3089 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. [325F.1791] CERTAIN ANTIBACTERIAL PRODUCTS; SALE
1.4 PERMITTED UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

1.5 Subdivision 1. **Generally.** A person may offer for sale in Minnesota a product that
1.6 contains only trace amounts of triclosan, triclocarban, or similar antibacterial compounds
1.7 and may label the product as "triclosan free."

1.8 Subd. 2. **Exception.** Subdivision 1 applies only if the trace amounts of triclosan,
1.9 triclocarban, or similar antibacterial compounds referenced in subdivision 1 were caused
1.10 by the raw materials or the manufacturing process and were not added by the seller.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2015, and applies to
1.12 products offered for sale or sold on or after that date."

1.13 Delete the title and insert:

1.14 "A bill for an act
1.15 relating to commerce; providing consumer protection; permitting products that
1.16 contain triclosan or similar antibacterial compounds to be labeled as "triclosan
1.17 free" only under certain circumstances; proposing coding for new law in
1.18 Minnesota Statutes, chapter 325F."
