

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 4066 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 326.3361, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.4 to read:

1.5 Subd. 1a. **Classification of duties for protective agents and employees; training**
1.6 **requirements.** (a) As provided for in this subdivision, the legislature recognizes five tiers
1.7 of security services.

1.8 (b) "Tier 1 security services" include facility or event access control, crowd flow, and
1.9 traffic and parking control. Tier 1 security services may require minimal use of force with
1.10 no expectation of detaining persons.

1.11 (c) "Tier 2 security services" include building access control, patrols, and escorting
1.12 visitors with no expectation of detaining trespassers or other persons suspected of criminal
1.13 conduct.

1.14 (d) "Tier 3 security services" include providing unarmed high-risk building security and
1.15 detaining trespassers or other persons suspected of criminal conduct.

1.16 (e) "Tier 4 security services" include providing armed security in a high-risk environment,
1.17 such as armored transport or critical infrastructure.

1.18 (f) "Tier 5 security services" include providing armed security for an individual or a
1.19 group.

1.20 (g) License holders who provide security services must attempt to match an employee's
1.21 skills and training with the highest tier of security service the employee is assigned to
1.22 provide. Nothing in this paragraph authorizes an employer to assign an employee or an

2.1 employee to perform duties for which the employee has not completed the minimum statutory
2.2 and administrative training requirements.

2.3 (h) The board must consider the security service tiers when enacting or revising rules
2.4 governing preemployment and continuing education training requirements for persons who
2.5 provide security services."
