- 2.2 that measure outcomes, not inputs;
- 2.3 (3) discuss the extent to which each performance measure is reliable and verifiable,

- 2.6 the extent to which the budget devoted to the activity has permitted or prevented the
- 2.7 agency from meeting its performance goals;
