




Total Probation and Supervised Release Experiencing Homelessness as of Jan 19th, 2021




Total Probation and Supervised Release Experiencing Homelessness as of Jan 19th, 2021




People Experiencing Homelessness & Non-Homelessness After Releases from Minnesota Correctional Facilities




All Individuals Released from MN Correctional Facilities Experiencing Unsheltered Homelessness – 2019 & 2020




Native American Women Releasing into Unsheltered Homelessness from MCF-Shakopee – 2019 & 2020
