1.10	receives aid under this section must report the following information to the commissioner
1.11	of public safety in the form and manner prescribed by the commissioner of public safety:
1.12	(1) the amount of aid received; and
1.13	(2) the ways in which the aid was used or is intended to be used.
1.14	(b) By, 2024, the commissioner of public safety must compile the information
1.15	received from counties, Tribal governments, or local units pursuant to paragraph (a) and
1.16	submit the compiled data to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over public safety
1.17	finance and policy.
