As an employee at Renewing the Countryside, I want to share the importance of this bill. This increase in funding will allow us to develop stronger farm to school and early care initiatives, build supply chains and increase food safety in Minnesota School Districts. As the manager of a Farmers Market that is a food hub conducting the Farmers Market Aggregation project, leadership team member and early proponent of Farm to School I have seen firsthand the difference this makes in my community.

As a farmer myself, I can speak to the impact it makes on farmers directly. This encourages relationships with their local schools, which is a win-win in every community. When farmers work with the local schools, we can create a learning environment around where foods comes from and teach children that their food choices impact their health and wellbeing.
