1.4 Subd. 2. **Eligible projects.** (a) An economic development project for which a county or
1.5 city may be eligible to receive a grant under this section includes:

1.6 (1) manufacturing;

1.7 (2) technology;

1.8 (3) warehousing and distribution;

1.9 (4) research and development;

1.10 (5) agricultural processing, defined as transforming, packaging, sorting, or grading
1.11 livestock or livestock products into goods that are used for intermediate or final consumption,
1.12 including goods for nonfood use; or

1.13 (6) industrial park development that would be used by any other business listed in this
1.14 subdivision even if no business has committed to locate in the industrial park at the time
1.15 the grant application is made.

1.16 (b) Up to 15 percent of the development of a project may be for a purpose that is ancillary
1.17 to the project, but that is not included under this subdivision as an eligible project. A city
1.18 or county must provide notice to the commissioner for the commissioner's approval of the
1.19 proposed ancillary development purpose.

2.1 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 116J.431, is amended by adding a subdivision
2.2 to read:

2.3 Subd. 3a. **Development restrictions expiration.** After ten years from the date of the
2.4 grant award under this section, a project that has been developed for its original project
2.5 purpose may be developed for any lawful purpose."

2.6 Page 1, after line 9, insert:

2.7 "Sec. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2.8 Sections 1 and 2 are effective the day following final enactment and apply to projects
2.9 that have been funded previously under Minnesota Statutes, section 116J.431. "
