


Strive to balance measurement & performance improvement

- 1. Process measures for:
 - Heart Failure
 - Pneumonia
 - Heart Attacks
 - Surgical Care
 - Pediatric Asthma
- 2. HCAHPS Patient experience ratings
- 3. Healthcare associated infections, reported to CDC

- 4. Participation in clinical databases for:
 - Cardiac Surgery
 - Stroke
 - Nursing-sensitive indicators
 - General surgery
- 5. Claims-based measures
 - 30-day mortality for heart failure, heart attack, and pneumonia
 - 30-day readmissions for heart failure, heart attack, and pneumonia
 - Patient safety indicators (e.g. post-op DVT)
 - Hospital acquired conditions (e.g. pressure ulcers)
