

Women, Infants and Children (WIC). COVID Supplement - cash value vouchers	8,084
Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV). Supports efforts to improve the health and developmental outcomes for at-risk children through evidenced-based home visiting programs.	3,400
Clean Air Act and Safe Drinking Water Act. Addresses health disparities related to pollution and the impacts of the COVID-19 Pandemic.	1,000
Youth Suicide Prevention and Early Intervention. Builds local capacity and strengthen youth suicide prevention and early intervention strategies to decrease suicide.	335
National Health Service Corps. Addresses health professional shortage areas.	1,800
Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Enhancing Detection. Supports testing, contract tracing, surveillance, containment, and mitigation efforts.	751,140
