| 1 | <b>General prohibitions.</b><br>Amends a section of the Minnesota Human Rights Act providing specific instances of discrimination against persons with disabilities to include that places of public accommodation must provide closed-captioned television when television is provided at that location to others. |
| 2 | <b>Implementation.</b><br>Requires places of public accommodation to comply with the requirements for closed-captioned television by August 1, 2024.  |
