#### Role of the Clemency Review Commission

- Screen all clemency applications for eligibility and hold hearings for all eligible applications
- Recommend to the Board whether to grant or deny
- Recommend whether the Board should hold an additional hearing
- Provide victim services
- Provide assistance to applicants
- Carry out administrative functions of the Board of Pardons through appointed Executive Director and staff




#### Agency Results

- Independent agency established as of July 1, 2024
- 5 commission meetings, 8+ committee meetings in 2024
- New website mn.gov/crc
- Dedicated victim services provider
- Outreach and application assistance grant program established

#### **Victim Services**

- Minnesota Alliance on Crime provides services for victims and survivors that interact with the CRC
- 55 applications (68%) heard by the CRC in 2024 had at least one case file that had a direct victim(s).
- Since engaging MAC in September:
  - 77 individual victims/survivors were identified and provided notice
    - 32 victims did not return contact
    - 45 victims responded

- Opposed (30%)
- Supported (19%)
- Took No Position (9%)



# FY 2026–27 Governor's Recommended Biennial Budget: \$2 Million

- \$995 for FY26; \$1,005 for FY 27 and thereafter (dollars in thousands)
  - \$795 (FY26); \$805 (FY27) operating funds
  - \$200 in FY 26 and FY 27 for outreach and application assistance grant program
- Maintain staffing to process applications at current rate
