1.18 Subd. 4. **Report required.** (a) Whenever a peace officer investigates an allegation that  
1.19 ~~an incident described in subdivision 1 has occurred, whether or not an arrest is made,~~ a  
1.20 person has committed a qualified domestic violence-related offense and the victim is a  
1.21 family or household member, the officer shall make a written police report of the alleged

2.1 incident regardless of whether an arrest is made. The report must contain at least the following  
2.2 information: the name, address and telephone number of the victim, if provided by the  
2.3 victim, a statement as to whether an arrest occurred, the name of the arrested person, and a  
2.4 brief summary of the incident. Data that identify a victim who has made a request under  
2.5 section 13.82, subdivision 17, paragraph (d), and that are private data under that subdivision,  
2.6 shall be private in the report required by this section. A copy of this report must be provided  
2.7 upon request, at no cost, to the victim of domestic abuse, the victim's attorney, or  
2.8 organizations designated by the Office of Justice Programs in the Department of Public  
2.9 Safety that are providing services to victims of domestic abuse. The officer shall submit the  
2.10 report to the officer's supervisor or other person to whom the employer's rules or policies  
2.11 require reports of similar allegations of criminal activity to be made.

2.12 (b) As used in this subdivision:

2.13 (1) "qualified domestic violence-related offense" has the meaning given in section 609.02,  
2.14 subdivision 16; and

2.15 (2) "family or household member" has the meaning given in section 518B.01, subdivision  
2.16 2, paragraph (b)."
