## **Bill Description**

This bill modifies provisions governing the certification of underground telecommunications installers; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 326B.198, subdivisions 2, 3.

MS 326B.198 (2024) requires that the installation of underground telecommunications infrastructure that is located within 10 feet of existing underground utilities or that crosses the existing underground utilities be performed by a certified safetyqualified underground telecommunications installer (Installer). Notably, this bill:

-Reduces the duration of the required certification training for Installers from 40 hours to 10 hours

-Changes the beginning effective date to January 1, 2026, state-wide, which eliminates the current staggered effective date for the seven-county metropolitan area (July 1, 2025);

-Exempts the installation of underground telecommunications infrastructure on private property under 36 inches in depth (essentially exempting residential areas); and

-Eliminates the requirement that no fewer than two Installers be present at all times at any location where telecommunications infrastructure is being installed by means of directional drilling.

### Assumptions

The Commissioner of Labor and Industry (DLI) is responsible for overseeing standards for the safety-qualified underground telecommunications installer certification program. This authority includes approving training programs, and an accompanying exam, submitted by external providers for trainees to demonstrate knowledge of the course materials. Certification would require applicants to complete a 10-hour initial course and pass an exam administered through a department-approved training provider. The certification is valid for three years, and a four-hour refresher course is required every three years thereafter to maintain certification.

The certification requirement is similar to that of individual pipelayers who are required to complete pipe laying training as prescribed by the commissioner (Minn. Stat. 326B.46, subd. 1); however, department-approved training providers manage the logistics of the certification program. DLI approved training providers administer the initial course and prescribed exam and issue corresponding certifications. With this individual certificate requirement, there is no requirement that the Installer's employer hold any type of business license or file a bond with the Department.

The changes outlined in this bill would not impact the current staff time dedicated to this certification program. DLI staff would continue to review training programs, exams, refresher courses, monitor & update relevant resources, and provide guidance and direction to stakeholders.

## **Bill Description**

SF-908 would revise installation requirements for underground telecommunications and reduce the number of hours required for certification standards from 40 hours to 10 hours.

#### **Assumptions**
