1.22 is more than 30 days in arrears in court-ordered child support that is collected or enforced

2.14 provide student awards for up to or more than 100 percent of tuition, 100 percent of tuition
2.15 and fees, or 100 percent of the cost of attendance, shall provide the Office of Higher
2.16 Education with student level data on the recipients of those awards and the program funds
2.17 awarded per term. The information under this subdivision is necessary for the office to
2.18 accurately complete reporting requirements under section 136A.121, subdivision 19.
