

COVID-19 Impacts on Minnesota



- More than 454,000 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Minnesota and 6,131 deaths
- More than 1 Million
 Minnesotan workers have
 filed for unemployment
 benefits since March 16
- Projected 2020 GDP -7.4%
 (May) from +2.1% (February)
- \$2.426 billion projected deficit (before use of budget reserve)

Rising to the Occasion

State agency employees have spent more than 1.8 million hours responding to COVID-19 since the pandemic began.

MMB has led these efforts by:

- Implementing cost savings measures, such as a hiring freeze and early retirement incentives;
- Activating a statewide employee redevelopment center;
