1.17 Subd. 1a. **Delinquent cannabis business; report.** The county auditor shall report to the  
1.18 commissioner of revenue any cannabis business, as defined in section 342.01, subdivision  
1.19 14, that is deemed delinquent pursuant to subdivision 1."
